



On a given day, we can head to a park to watch trains, go beachcombing and take a run down a salmon slide; hike to an amazing waterfall; or take a ferry ride with views and room to explore.

adventure is sharing it with

your top picks and new favorites
for family fun.


From Beatles covers to eminently singable pop songs to original lullabies (most recently in his new album, *Night Night*), **Caspar Babypants** (*babypantsmusic.com*) creates some of the catchiest kids' tunes around. Don't miss one of his highly engaging, never overwhelming live concerts, where — if you're lucky — he might compose a new song on the spot.

Finalists:

As a ParentMap reviewer noted this year, **Seattle Children's Theatre** (SCT, *sct. org*) is not just good for a kid's theater. It is one of Seattle's best theater companies. SCT's productions are consistently excellent, entertaining and thought-provoking for any age. And its next season — with a range of shows, from *Chitty Chitty Bang Bang* to *Brooklyn Bridge* — is a fantastic lineup.

Magician Evan Reynolds started **Evan's Family Variety Show** as a way to showcase a variety of magic and circus arts — from magicians and jugglers to Hula-Hoopers — in a family-friendly format. Check *evan.org/shows/variety* for the date of the next show; they are often free, and each one is different.

Want a birthday-party performer who can literally pull a rabbit out of a hat? **Xakary the Magician** (*xakary.com*) is your magician. Parents rave about his talent, his humor and his ability to absolutely captivate a roomful of kids.





RAINY-DAY REFUGES Winner: Pacific Science Center

From a planetarium to dinosaurs to a butterfly house and hands-on fun at the Tinker Tank, **Pacific Science Center** (*pacificsciencecenter. org*) could keep kids happily exploring for days
— and this is before you get to the outdoor water wheel and high-rail bicycle (open during the summer). This summer, don't miss a jaw-dropping show at the recently upgraded Boeing IMAX theater, or "Grossology (The Impolite Science of the Human Body)," a hands-on exhibit that answers questions about boogers, burps and other bodily functions at the intersection of "Ick!" and "Cool!"

Finalists

Lynnwood's **PlayHappy Café** (*playhappy cafe.com*, formerly known as PlayDate Café) is a home away from home for many Puget Sound parents, boasting a bright, toy-packed, 2,000-square-foot play space for kids ages newborn–6 years old, an excellent café for parents (Caffe Ladro drinks, salads, smoothies, sandwiches) and programs ranging from dance classes to a preschool.

Located in a sizzling spot near all the fun of South Lake Union, **PlayDate SEA** (*playdatesea.com*) is an 8,000-foot,

Atlantis-themed playscape with slides, climbing towers, tunnels, a ball-cannon area and a grown-up-friendly café area. Tip: On the last

Wednesday of the month admission is free with a canned-food donation.



WiggleWorks Kids (*wiggleworkskids.com*), with locations that include a recently expanded space at Crossroads in Bellevue and in Puyallup, is a spotless, moving, highly engaging playscape where wee ones (kids less than 48 inches tall) can swing on giant balls, chase balloons, run, hop and wiggle away.

URBAN NATURE EXPERIENCES

Winner: Discovery Park

Wild **Discovery Park** (*seattle.gov/parks/environment/discovery.htm*), a former military base that is the largest park in Seattle, has it all. From the 2.8-mile trail loop through forests, meadows and along bluffs with breathtaking views to driftwood-tossed beaches and even a lighthouse, the range of nature experiences in Seattle's largest park is astounding.

Finalists

Follow the winding road down to **Carkeek Park** (*seattle.gov/parks/environment/carkeek. htm*) and you've thoroughly escaped the city.



Wander the creekside trails (look for spawning salmon in the fall), study tidal life and climb logs on the spectacular rocky beach, and wear 'em out at the playground with a view (best known for its salmon slide).

On the shores of Lake Washington, **Saint Edward State Park** (*parks.wa.gov/577/Saint-Edward*) is another can't-miss favorite, with miles of trails, lake swimming and a famous castle-themed playground surrounded by forest (on a hot day, it's paradise). Keep an eye out for bald eagles and otters.

Incomparable foliage in the fall, a fragrant winter garden from November to March, blossoms galore in the spring: The 230-acre **Washington Park Arboretum** (*depts. washington.edu/uwbg/gardens/wpa.shtml*) is a wonderful destination any time of the year. Kids love the wetland trails, hidden ponds and bridges and the nature programs (check out the Fiddleheads Forest preschool).

BIRTHDAY VENUESWinner: Pump It Up

From a themed party where your kiddo can become a pirate or superhero to a brilliant glow-in-the-dark fest, **Pump It Up** — with locations in Kirkland, Lynnwood and Bothell — knows how to deliver the parties kids love (*pumpitupparty.com*). Bonus: Parties are always private; it's just your guests in both the play area and the party room.



in Snohomish (bobscorn.com) is another fall favorite for readers. Pick a squash from the large U-pick field, get lost in the 10-acre corn maze and reserve a fire pit for an evening gathering (birthday party alert!).

TOURIST IN YOUR OWN TOWN

Winner: Pike Place Market From the fish throwers, buskers and

Hmong flower sellers in the openair market to the kitschy magic and comic shops that burrow beneath, the 108-year-old **Pike Place**Market (pikeplacemarket.org) always offers something new. Enjoy the traditional highlights — visit the gum wall, watch cheese being made

at Beecher's and picnic at view-rich

Victor Steinbrueck Park — but also take time to find your own market discoveries.

Finalists

With award-winning exhibits designed to mimic natural animal habitats, **Woodland Park Zoo** (*zoo. org*) is one of the top zoos in the country, with a mission dedicated to education and conservation. Don't miss the tigers and sloth bears in the new Banyan Wilds exhibit, quirkier species such as Komodo dragons and warthogs, and the pigs and chickens at the Family Farm.

Washington State Ferries

(wsdot.wa.gov/ferries) is the classic cheap thrill for tourists and locals alike, with views, fresh air, wildlife sightings and room to spread out. Take the ferry to Bremerton to splash in the volcano fountains; to Bainbridge for museums and foodie fun; or to Kingston for beach time and ice cream. Or buy some popcorn and Ivar's clam chowder and settle in for the ride.

Quack, quack! No need to wait for visitors to indulge in **Ride the Ducks** (*ridetheducksofseattle. com*), a series of land-and-water tours in Seattle that are informative and hilarious. Expect a guide who narrates with jokes, music and funky dancing.

CAMPS + CLASSES

We in the Northwest love to keep our kids' calendars full with camps, classes and lessons. And why wouldn't we, when we have so many amazing choices? Free time is important, yes. And we want to make sure our children have the chance to explore and discover their passion. Will it be music, sports, science, dance, drama, the outdoors or something else? Think of all the fun and learning to be had as they find out.

STEM CAMPS Winner: Girls Rock Math

Your votes crowned **Girls Rock Math** (*girlsrockmathematics.com*) the queen among our region's many STEM camp opportunities. Parents appreciate that Girls Rock Math's unique camps and workshops make math real — and really fun — for girls. Campers in grades 1–6 build confidence and friendships while using math together with the arts to dig in to crafts, painting, gardening, fashion and more. Fun-sounding camp themes include "Crafty Math," "Mathmagical Garden" and "Bead-dazzling Math." Girls Rock Math offers its weeklong day camps in eight Seattle-area and Eastside locations.

Finalists

The venerable **Pacific Science Center** (*pacificsciencecenter.org*) earned scores of your votes for its STEM camps focusing on marine science, cooking, medicine, robotics and much more. Campers study the center's resident critters, connect chemistry and cooking, or learn

the science behind solving crimes. A wide array of camps welcomes kids from pre-K through high school and meets in six Seattle and Eastside locations.

It's little wonder our resident research university would garner your votes for its STEM programs for kids in grades 1–12. **The University of Washington's Summer Youth Programs** (*summer-camp.uw.edu*) offer popular two-week camps and short courses on topics to suit the interests of just about every kid, from robotics, game design and programming to puppet making, architecture and green energy.

You enthusiastically support **Girl Scouts of Western Washington**'s (*girlscoutsww.org*) opportunities to get girls outside in nature at its three area camps: Camps Robbinswold, St. Albans and River Ranch welcome girls for exploration in marine environments, including canoeing, sailing and low-tide study; in animal science, with horse and llama pack trips; and other camps. No prior Girl Scouts experience required.

THEATER CAMPS AND PROGRAMS

Winner: Seattle Children's Theatre

A recent ParentMap review described Seattle Children's Theatre's (SCT, sct.org) Robin Hood as possibly "the best play you'll see this year with or without your kids." It makes sense that one of our area's premier theater companies also offers high-quality theater education for kids, as you well know. One voter raved about the faculty and called the theater "our city treasure." SCT's summer and school-break camps, classes and workshops serve kids in pre-K to grade 12. Some camps follow themes, such as "Drama Quest — COD3 BR3AK3RS," "Treasure Trunk Theatre" and "Acting for the Camera"; other camps rehearse a specific show. Programs are offered at SCT's Seattle Center location and other locations in the greater Seattle area. >>

Finalists

Tacoma Musical Playhouse

(TMP, tmp.org) aims to offer kids an enriching experience in musical-theater arts through its education programs, and your votes confirm it's doing a great job. You appreciate TMP's emphasis on teamwork as summer and schoolbreak campers rehearse and perform a full show. Upcoming camps include 101 Dalmatians for younger campers and Rent for high-school ages. Workshops and after-school programs teach acting, singing and dance, and serve kids ages 4–18.

You love **Wedgwood Drama Studio**'s (*wedgwooddrama.com*) Theater in the Park summer camps, which combine fun theater exploration with playing outside. Outdoor camps in northeast Seattle serve kids in preschool–grade 5, and Wedgwood also runs after-school programs at local elementary schools, community classes and a Summer Lab for grades 6–12. One voter commended the studio's focus on "play, movement, creativity and authentic expression."

Village Theatre's KidStage (villagetheatre. org) earned your votes for its diverse array of education programs, taking place in Issaquah and Everett. Summer camps tap into the popularity of movie and book characters, with camp themes around Frozen, Curious George, Star Wars and Junie B. Jones. KidStage also offers ongoing full production opportunities for youth actors and a theater apprentice program.



ATHLETICS CAMPS AND PROGRAMS

Winner: Pro Sports Club

Bellevue's **Pro Sports Club** (*proclub.com*) garnered heaps of votes for its first-rate youth sports programs. The club's amenities extend beyond those of a typical gym, and you appreciate this convenience. Many Pro Sports Club youth sports instructors are coaches or former elite athletes, and you're thrilled with the skills they're teaching your kids. The club's programs offer instruction in popular team sports such as soccer and basketball, as well as aquatics, squash, tennis and racquetball. Summer camps expand kids' specific skills in ball handling and shooting in basketball, and offer exposure to variety of other active pursuits, including kickball, dodgeball, floor hockey, laser tag, inflatables and iDance.

Finalists

Kids have been playing sports at their local **YMCA**s for generations, and, according to your votes, the tradition continues today. The Little Gym (thelittlegym.com) knows kids rarely stop moving their bodies. You are enthusiastic about its ability to focus this energy into developing sports skills, coordination and having fun. The Little Gym's dozen Puget Soundarea locations make it super convenient and fun for your kiddos to explore gymnastics, sports skills, karate and dance.

You voted in droves for North Seattle's **Creative Dance Center** (*creativedance.org*), continuing


